RingGo ePay supports the removal of machines, by offering motorists that cannot or do not wish to pay by card and mobile phone, a means of paying with cash.

Motorists follow the sign directions to the nearest ePay shop and pay for their parking in store. The retailer records the vehicle registration and location details via the ePay terminal, and details are transferred to the central parking database. With all information recorded digitally, ANPR assisted enforcement can be used to highlight vehicles that have not paid.
